## Literary Analysis Essay Rubric

<b>Introduction</b>	<b>/ 10</b>
- Grabs reader's attention, is interesting and relevant, is at least three sentences	
<b>Thesis Statement</b>	<b>/ 10</b>
- Thesis is clear, is in the discussed format, has three clear points of analysis	
<b>Organization</b>	<b>/ 10</b>
- Essay is logically organized, paragraphs have relevant topic sentences and clear transitions	
<b>Evidence</b>	<b>/ 20</b>
- Evidence from novel is appropriately and effectively integrated into the essay, author's own words introduce and then explain evidence	
<b>Conclusion</b>	<b>/ 10</b>
- Conclusion is effective and leaves the reader thinking; is not just re-stating what was already said, is at least three sentences	
<b>Conventions</b>	<b>/ 15</b>
- Very few errors in structure, grammar, spelling, and punctuation	
<b>Citations</b>	<b>/ 10</b>
- Novel is cited and citations are in correct format. Works Cited page is included and in proper format	
<b>Other</b>	<b>/ 15</b>
- Essay is double-spaced, written in 12-pt. font, has 1-inch margins, includes proper MLA header. Paper is 5 (or more) paragraphs long
